

CARE AND CLEANING FOR LIGHTING:

All of our glass products are handmade. Each color is hand formulated so one can expect color variation from piece to piece. Because the glass pieces are hand blown freehand or into molds, each shape is one of a kind. These characteristics should not be considered defects but part of the beauty of the piece. Please note that mirrored glass parts will age and antique over time. Oxidation is an inherent characteristic of mirrored pieces.

It is important to maintain your glass item. For metal portions of your fixture, maintain by wiping with a clean dry microfiber cloth. For smooth and shiny glass pieces, use a clean microfiber cloth to remove any dust that may have built up. To clean away dirt, use a mild-vinegar water solution being careful not to get the hardware, metal components, or cord wet. For any sandblasted glass surfaces, wipe down with a clean microfiber cloth to remove dust. Please be aware that oil from your fingers will leave spots on sandblasted finishes. If this happens, it is best to rub down the piece with a very small amount of mineral oil applied to a cloth to even out the spotting. Be aware however that this will decrease the sandblasted appearance of the finish.

CARE AND CLEANING FOR MIRRORS:

All of our mirrors are handmade. Some are designed to look like vintage mirrors. Please note that mirrored glass parts will age and antique over time. Oxidation is an inherent characteristic of mirrored pieces and is not considered a flaw.

It is important to maintain your mirror. For metal portions of your piece, maintain by wiping with a clean dry microfiber cloth. For glass and mirrored areas, use a clean microfiber cloth to remove any dust that may have built up. To clean away dirt from the glass portions, use a cloth with a mild-vinegar water solution on the surface only. Be careful not to get the hardware or metal portions of the mirror wet.

CARE AND CLEANING FOR HINSON LIGHTING:

It is important to maintain your Hinson fixture. For metal portions of your fixture, maintain by wiping with a clean dry microfiber cloth. To clean away dirt (except hand rubbed finishes without any protective top coat), spot clean by carefully using a mild-vinegar water solution applied to a cloth. Be careful not to get the hardware or cord wet.
